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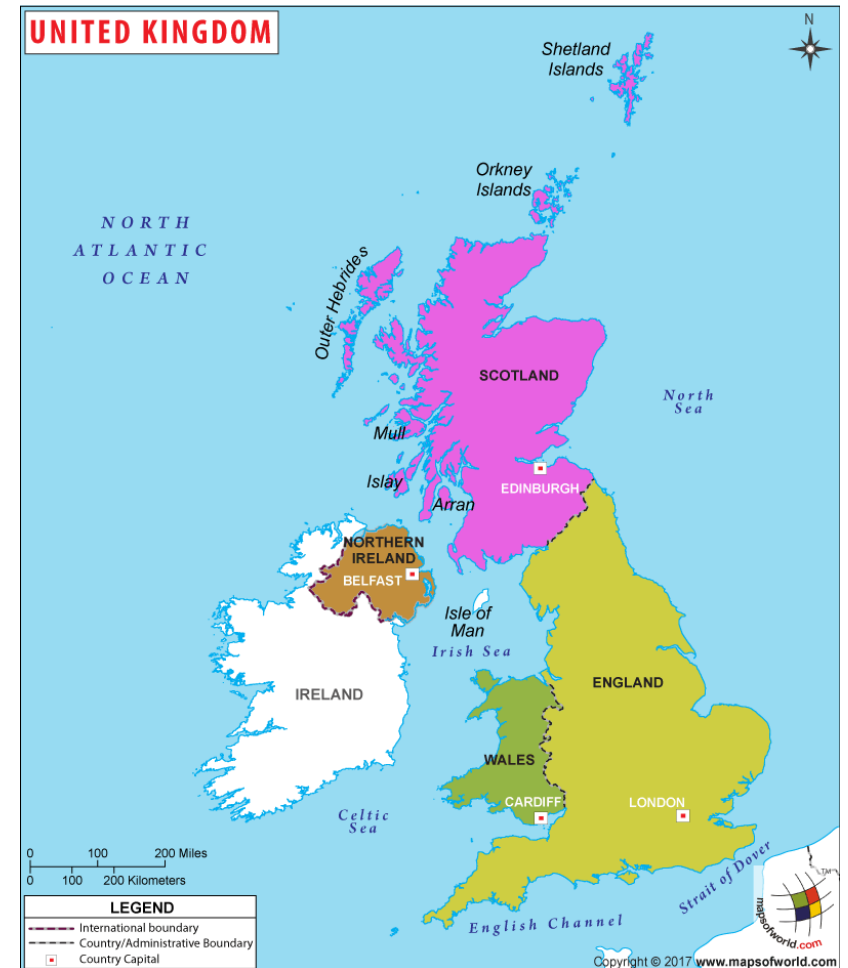
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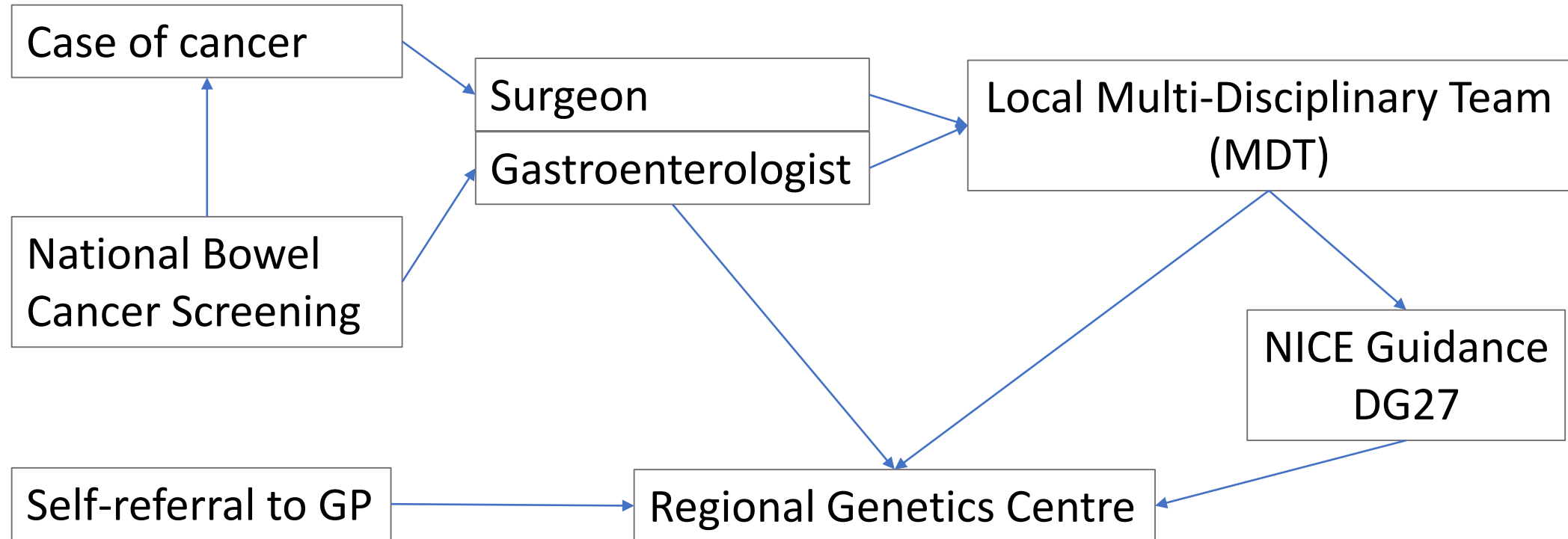
UK Familial Bowel Cancer Syndromes

- The UK has :-
- 4 countries; each has its own *NHS*
- Genetics is a Regional Specialty
 - organised in Regional Centres (1.8 ~ 6.4M popn)
- England = 26
- Scotland = 4
- Wales = 1
- N. Ireland = 1
- (Ireland = 1)
